Greetings from Nuu Technical and Vocational College fraternity.

By the grace of the Almighty God, we have come to the end of the term successfully. We take this opportunity to thank you, most sincerely for your commitment, determination and focus which made our diverse programs possible.

KEY HIGHLIGHTS.

1. Drama Festival 2025

We are delighted to inform you that our trainees successfully participated in Regional Drama Festival held between 14th and 16th March 2025. The college emerged the best institution overall and it will present five items at National Drama and Film Competitions namely; Play, Choral Verse, Creative Cultural Dance, and Solo Verse, which will be held between 7th and 14th April 2025 in Nakuru.

2. January 2025 Mass Enrolment

The exercise was done successfully. The college was able to enroll a total of 320 trainees who will be trained in different skills. The marketing drive is ongoing and more trainees will enroll in May 2025. It is important to note that TVET institutions are key in hands-on skills which will assist the trainees to either get employed/be self-employed in their counties, outside the county or even abroad.

3. Season I KATTI - Athletics and Indoor games

The Institution is preparing trainees who will participate in the KATTI season I games - Athletics and Indoor games in May 2025.

4. Assessments

The administration has noted that a number of trainees do not take assessments seriously even after being advised. In line with the college **Academic Policy**, any trainee who misses assessment without a written explanation, leading to interference with Portfolio of Evidence, is required to sit for supplementary assessment and be charged Kshs. 500 per paper. This will discourage laziness as well as encourage timely completion of courses.

Lastly, after a successful session of end term CDACC Assessment, the trainees will be turning for classes/training from 5th May 2025.

5. Institution Fees Payment.

The College administration sincerely thanks the guardians/parents who paid the household component of the TVET funding model on time. Those with balances are therefore advised to clear before resumption of classes on 5th May 2025.

It is important to note, college fee for all TVET institutions is Kshs. 67,189 per year (exclusive of exam, registration, attachment and examination material fee). The number of years vary with the level of study. Trainees are encouraged to apply for HELB and Government Scholarships to reduce the burden of fee payment. Any trainee who has not applied for HELB or SCHOLARSHIP falls in the category of self-sponsored student and the parent/guardian should pay the whole amount.
