1. May – August 2026 Term Opening & Admissions

New Student Admissions:

Registration for the May 2026 intake is currently underway and will close on 15th May 2026. We offer placements in CBET Modular curriculum, Dual Training, and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL).

Why Enroll Early?

We encourage early enrollment to ensure trainees have sufficient time to cover their coursework and prepare thoroughly for modular assessments. Please help us spread the word to prospective trainees.

Reporting Dates for Continuing Trainees:

Continuing trainees are expected to report back on 4th May 2026. Training will officially commence on 5th May 2026 for May – August 2026 term.

2. Co-Curricular Highlights: Drama and Film Festivals

In March 2026, our trainees proudly represented the college at the Regional Drama and Film Festival held at Mwala Technical and Vocational College. Our team delivered impressive performances across various categories, including Play, Dramatized Choral Verse, Creative Cultural Dance, Solo Verse, Oral Narrative, Stand-up Comedy, Mime, and Spoken Word.

Following their excellence in the Play, Dramatized Choral Verse, and Oral Narrative categories, our students advanced to the National Drama and Film Festival at Nyeri National Polytechnic, which began on 9th April 2026.

3. Modular CBET Training

In alignment with the recent policy resolutions from the State Department for TVET:

- Formal admission into our mainstream TVET programmes is standardized to commence at Level 4 (formerly Artisan) and above.

- Any programs below Level 4 are now categorized as short courses. The college continues to design these as demand-driven programmes to meet local and regional labor market needs. A comprehensive list of these short courses will be released soon.

4. Assessments

- We congratulate all trainees who completed their assessments this term. Their hard work is highly commendable.
- As we transition fully to modular curriculum in May 2026 (all timetabled courses are CBET modular), it is vital that any trainees with pending KNEC assessments register for the July/August 2026 series. The college will not offer KNEC registrations after this date.
- Registration for the July/August 2026 TVET – CDACC assessments is now open. Trainees should visit the assessments office to confirm requirements and register.
- Kindly note that, a trainee may only proceed to the next module after successfully clearing all assessments for the current module.

5. Institutional Fees and Payment Information

We appreciate the parents and guardians who settled tuition and assessment fees on time. Those with outstanding balances are advised to clear or reduce them before training resumes on 5th May 2026.

May – August 2026 Term Fees

As you may be aware, the annual TVET fee has been reduced to Kshs. 67,189, as indicated in the fee structure provided below:

Important Fee Notes:

- The total amount indicated in the fee structure includes the admission fee (for new trainees), as well as Assessment and Material fees.
- The Assessment Fee is payable upon booking and follows the official TVET-CDACC rates. Please note that this payment will be deducted from the total annual fee balance.
- To support practical training activities, every trainee is required to provide Kshs. 5,000 per term for training and assessment materials. This amount is part of the total annual fee and will be deducted from the overall balance upon payment.
